AP European History Centuries Project

Purpose

The Advanced Placement European History exam covers a large volume of history. Preparation for such an exam is a time consuming and arduous task. This project aims to make it easier. You will be divided into one of six groups, corresponding to the six centuries of AP European History. Your group will create a review packet for each area, and they will be distributed to each member of the class.

Procedure

The review packet you create will encompass all of the points for your century. These centuries are very broad and open ended; therefore it is incumbent upon your group to fill in as much information as possible for your theme, pulling from everything the class has studied this year. Your packet should include the following items

- 1. Vocabulary section with definitions and explanations
- 2. Important documents, treaties, wars, political leaders, art, etc with a description/explanation of importance
- 3. Surveys of the major points, detailing as much information as possible.
- 4. Sample essay questions
- 5. Sample multiple choice questions

- 2. 1500s Sixteenth Century
- 3. 1600s Seventeenth Century
- 4. 1700s Eighteenth Century
- 5. 1800s Nineteenth Century
- 6. 1900s Twentieth Century

Grading

There will be two grades for this project, one for the group and one for the individual. The group grade will be based on the overall effect of the packet – Does it adequately cover the material? The individual grade will be based on how well each individual completes their section or part of the packet. Are the explanations clear and accurate? Is all of the necessary information included?
