

## Jacksonian Democracy App Smash Project

Your assignment is to work in groups up to three to explain an important conflict during the period called Jacksonian Democracy (1824-1840) in a video at least two minutes long. The project will be created using a smartphone/tablet/computer, and you will share your project to Mr. Androstic by the end of class on Tuesday, November 21. For this project, you will create the video using a number of different smartphone apps to creatively tell your story. You must use at least **THREE** different apps to create this project, including, but not limited to, audio apps, photoshop apps, and video/presentation apps. You will create the project, but will also share with Mr. Androstic a summary of your production process, including explaining what apps you used to create what portions of your project.
