PAPERLESS BONUS:

Bonus points may be earned during the completion of this learning menu by avoiding the use of computer paper to complete the assignments. Of course, hard copies of any assignments will be made available to you, but ideally we will try to conserve paper as much as possible. If you complete all the assignments on this menu that are required for an A (completing all three tiers), you may earn bonus points to be applied to your grade on the following scale:

- 10 bonus points if you use <2 pieces of school computer paper to complete your assignments
- 5 bonus points if you use 3-4 pieces of school computer paper
- 0 bonus points if you use 5 or more pieces of computer paper

Please note: paperless bonus does not count your own paper, notebook paper, construction paper or posterboard.
